English language and admission requirements

A range of tests and evidence of English language equivalency are accepted for entry into TAFE courses. For entry into most certificate, diploma and advanced diploma courses, we require the equivalent of an IELTS (academic) score of 6.0 with no band score less than 5.0. When you apply directly to TIWA for a TAFE course, our admissions team will assess whether or not you require an English Language Intensive Courses for Overseas Students (ELICOS).
